

**PM To Break Fast With People In Bachok Sunday**

BACHOK, Aug 1 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will visit Kelantan on Sunday and break fast with the people in Bachok, said Kelantan Umno Liaison Committee deputy chairman Senator Datuk Dr Awang Adek Hussin.

He said Najib was scheduled to arrive in Bachok at 5 pm and break fast with the people at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Datuk Perdana in Tangok here.

The prime minister would also perform the "Terawih" prayers with the people at the Naim Mosque in Jelawat here, he told reporters after breaking fast with the staff of the Bachok Police district headquarters at the Jelawat police station here last night.

At the event, Awang Adek, who is the deputy finance minister, handed over aid to 20 police retirees and orphans.

Awang Adek, who is Bachok Umno Division head, said Najib would join the people of the Keteher parliamentary constituency for a "makan colek" (a Kelantan special seafood spread) at the Kelantan Poverty Alleviation Foundation in Melor, Kota Baharu.

He said Najib's visit would serve as a catalyst to make Bachok a hub for higher education in the east coast.

Bachok already had a strong foundation in education with the existence of Universiti Malaysia Kelantan (UMK), the Islamic College of Science and Technology (KIST) and the Maritime Research Centre of Universiti Malaya, he said.

He also said that tourism facilities were growing along the Bachok coast.
