

**Parliament Is Best Place To Highlight Issues Affecting Sabah, Says LDP President

KOTA KINABALU, Aug 1 (Bernama) -- Liberal Democratic Party (LDP) president Datuk VK Liew opined that Parliament is the best venue to highlight issues including the problems affecting Sabah, saying "if done effectively, many issues can be resolved".

Commenting on the revocation of Datuk Seri Lajim Ukin's appointment as Deputy Minister of Housing and Local Government effective Tuesday and United Pasokmomogun Kadazandusun Murut Organisation (Upko) deputy president Datuk Seri Wilfred Bumburing's departure from Barisan Nasional (BN), he said: "Well, now that it is said and done, we simply have to soldier on with the BN flag without them.
