

**No Politician Should Sit On PHEB, Says MIC Youth

GEORGE TOWN, Aug 3 (Bernama) -- The Penang Hindu Endowment Board (PHEB) should be revamped to ensure only people with a religious background are appointed as commissioners to support and develop the board, says the state MIC Youth.

Its chief J. Dhinakaran said the Penang government should stop appointing politicians as they would be busy and hence, had no time to attend to issues affecting the Hindus.

He said during the Barisan Nasional's administration, only the PHEB chairman was a politician while the others were professionals with credibility and integrity.

"But under the Pakatan state government, there are four politicians in PHEB including its chairman Dr P. Ramasamy, who is deputy chief minister," he told a press conference, here, Friday.
