

Rosmah Urges Holistic Assistance For Needy Children

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 3 (Bernama) -- The Prime Minister's wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor urged governmental and non-governmental bodies to provide holistic and comprehensive assistance to needy children and not focus only on their academic development.

She praised the Cheras Education Foundation (YPC) for conducting seminars for students and teachers in addition to presenting Hari Raya gifts to all its adopted schools.

Meanwhile, Cheras Umno division head and YPC chairman, Datuk Wira Syed Ali Alhabshee said RM400,000 was distributed to 394 students and 36 children from the Taman Sri Putri Cheras Home during the event.

The funds were donated by individuals, members of the corporate sector and several companies, he added.
