

Indonesian Foreign Minister To Attend NAM Meeting In Ramallah

JAKARTA, Aug 4 (Bernama) -- Indonesia Foreign Minister Marty Natalegawa will leave to Palestine tonight to attend the Non-Aligned Movement's (NAM) Extraordinary Ministerial Meeting of the Non-Aligned Movement Committee on Palestine in Ramallah on Sunday.

Indonesia Foreign Ministry's Information and Media director PLE Priatna said in a statement today that during the meeting Indonesia would reiterate its stand on the Palestine issue, calling for the need by NAM to take concrete steps to ensure peace and rights of the Palestinians.

Priatna said during the meeting Palestine President Mahmoud Abbas is expected to debate the measures and resolutions taken during the NAM meeting held in May 2011 in Sharm el Sheikh, Egypt.

Marty is also scheduled to hold bilateral talks and discussions with Palestine Foreign Minister Dr Riad Malki on issues involving Palestine and visit former Palestine President Yasser Arafat's mausoleum.
