

**BN Government Will Resolve Kelantan Water Woes – Najib

KOTA BAHARU, Aug 5 (Bernama) - Barisan Nasional (BN) will resolve Kelantan water woes if it captures the state in the general election.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said Kalantan people should not have water problem as they had been giving PAS the mandate since 1990.

"The BN government can solve this problem fast. While at the airport, I received a memorandum asking to resolve the water problem," he said before taraweh prayers at Kalantan Poverty Foundation here tonight attended by over 10,000 people.
