

Malaysia Condemns Israel's Action To Block Envoys

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 6 (Bernama) -- Malaysia today strongly condemned Israel's action which scuttled a proposed meeting of envoys from the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) in Ramallah over two days from yesterday.

The Foreign Ministry said in a statement that Israel had no valid reason to bar some of the foreign ministers and their delegations from Ramallah as it was located in Palestine and not in Israel.

Israel refused to admit four attendees from states with which it has no diplomatic relations.

"The Government of Malaysia strongly condemns Israel's action which violates international principles of law and Israel's obligation as the power occupying Palestine," said the statement.

The action taken by Israel again showed to NAM and the international community the sufferings of the Palestinians in their struggles to achieve full independence with Jerusalem as its capital.
