

**NAM Ministerial Committee Condemns Israel Over Meeting On Palestine**

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 6 (Bernama) -- The Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) Ministerial Committee on Palestine has condemned Israel for preventing it from holding a special meeting in Ramallah, Palestine, yesterday.

It called on the NAM Coordinating Bureau in New York to consider this "serious incident" further and take appropriate action.

"The committee deeply abhors the fact that it was unable to demonstrate its solidarity with the Palestinian people by holding its meeting in Ramallah," it said in a joint statement made available to the media here by the Foreign Ministry.

The committee said that in preventing the meeting from taking place, Israel, the occupying power, had used the feeble pretext that some of its members did not have relations with Israel, notwithstanding that the visit was to Ramallah, Palestine, and not Israel.

"The committee strongly condemns this blatant action by Israel. It s a flagrant violation of principles of international law and of Israel's obligations as the occupying power," it said.
