

**National Chinese Youth Leaders Assembly Best Platform To Voice Views

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 7 (Bernama) -- The 4th National Chinese Youth Leaders Assembly will be the best platform for Chinese youth to voice their opinions on various issues and to interact with political and non-governmental organisation (NGO) leaders.

Ong Leong Chiou, deputy president of the Malaysia Xiang Lian Youth Association, the event organiser, said the assembly which had the support of the Youth and Sports Ministry, would be held from Aug 30 to Sept 1 at MH Hotel and Residences, Cheras.
