

Selangor Sultan Reminds Muslims To Beware Of Deviant Teachings Spread In Devious Manner

BANTING, Aug 7 (Bernama) -- The Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah today reminded Muslims to beware of deviant religious teachings being spread in a planned and quiet manner, especially in Selangor.

He said Muslims in the state should be careful not to easily fall for the tactics of those who initially appeared to be kind and sincere in wanting to help them, but in fact, had a hidden agenda.

"These individuals will always try to influence Muslims with their deviant teachings or ideology which could lead them astray," said Sultan Sharafuddin when officially opening the Al-Islah Kampung Sawah Mosque, here, built at a cost of RM4.65 million and can accommodate a congregation of 1,500.

The Sultan said the Selangor Islamic Religious Council (MAIS) and Islamic Religious Department (JAIS) should monitor these deviant teachings and to take appropriate action against those spreading them to Muslims.

He also reminded Muslims to follow the Sunnah Wal Jamaah Islamic teachings as it is moderate and not too extreme, and practised by the majority of Muslims in this country.

The Sultan urged the officials and committee members of mosques to carry out their responsibilities to the best of their ability and with sincerity.

He also suggested that the congregations accept and respect the appointments of mosque committees made according to the stipulated procedure.
