

Different National Day Themes In States Under Opposition Shows Lack Of Consensus - Ahmad Maslan

SHAH ALAM, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- Using three different themes for the coming National Day celebration by states under opposition rule proves that they could not come to a consensus even over small matters, says Umno information chief Datuk Ahmad Maslan.

He said the lack of consensus among the opposition partners showed that they were "sleeping on the same pillow but having different dreams".

"They would never be one on any matter because they are a disagreeing opposition pact, hence Pakatan Rakyat is a misnomer," he said after handing out Aidilfitri contributions to 100 poor people, the disabled and single mothers at Kampung Bukit Lanchong, here, yesterday.

Also present were Senator Ezam Mohd Noor and Barisan Nasional coordinator for the Sri Muda state constituency, Kamaruzzaman Johari.

Ahmad was earlier asked to comment on the announcement by PAS secretary-general Datuk Mustafa Ali yesterday that the states under Pakatan Rakyat would be using different themes for the National Day celebration.
