

Rozali Calls On Selangor Government To Stop Pointing Fingers And Solve Water Issues

PETALING JAYA, Aug 8 (Bernama) -- Syarikat Bekalan Air Selangor (Syabas) executive chairman Tan Sri Rozali Ismail today called on the Selangor government to stop pointing fingers at other parties, including himself, in relations to the water issues in the state.
