

Ahmad Urges People To Retain Barisan Nasional Government

KUALA TERENGGANU, Aug 9 (Bernama) - The Barisan Nasional (BN) government must be retained because it is the only government that can champion the people.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Ahmad Said said this is necessary as the BN government has contributed a lot to the people over the years.

He said PAS never championed the people as they were only good at making pledges that were never fulfilled.

"I hope the people will give solid support to the government as it has proven by providing many facilities," he said when breaking fast with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak and some 10,000 people in Kuala Nerus parliamentary constituency here Thursday.

The government programmes for the people's benefit include Kedai Rakyat 1Malaysia, Klinik 1Malaysia and Bantuan Rakyat 1Malaysia.

Meanwhile, Member of Parliament for Kuala Nerus, Datuk Mohamad Nasir Ibrahim Fikri said the federal government has allocated RM100,000 to build houses for the poor and RM170,000 aid to the poor, single mothers and the disabled.

The Kuala Nerus Umno division chief pledged to defend the state seats of Tepoh, Seberang Takir and Teluk Pasu, retake Bukit Tunggal from PAS and defend Kuala Nerus parliamentary seat.
