

**Government Submits Preliminary Objection against Application By Lawyers To Quash Notice**

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 9 (Bernama) -- The government has submitted a preliminary objection against the application for judicial review by two lawyers to quash a notice issued to them by the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) relating to the National Feedlot Corporation (NFC).

Senior Federal Counsel Effandi Nazila Abdullah who appeared for the respondents told reporters outside the court Thursday after proceedings in chambers before Justice Abang Iskandar Abang Hashim that the government had objected to the application on the grounds that the notice issued by the MACC is not subjected to a review as it is not a decision.

He also disclosed that the High Court has fixed Sept 3 for decision on the objection.

Lawyers Latheefa Koya and Murnie Hidayah in their application had named the MACC, Malaysian government and MACC assistant superintendent Suziana Ali as respondents.

They contended that the notice dated March 19 requiring them to be present at the MACC headquarters in Putrajaya on March 23 to assist in investigations involving NFC executive chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mohamad Salleh Ismail was void and contravened provisions under 5(2) of the Federal Constitution.
