

Recruitment Of Bangladesh Workers Not Finalised Yet - Home Ministry

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 9 (Bernama) -- The recruitment of foreign workers from Bangladesh has not been finalised and needs to be scrutinised as the mechanism involved government to government, according to a statement from the Home Ministry's foreign workers' management division today.

It said the decision was reached at the eighth cabinet meeting on foreign workers and illegal immigrants chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin in Putrajaya Thursday.

Among the cabinet ministers present were Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohamed Nazri Abdul Aziz, Tourism Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ng Yen Yen and International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed.

The meeting also agreed that Human Resource Minister Datuk Seri Dr S. Subramaniam would lead a delegation on a working visit to Bangladesh to see the system adopted by the government and that of South Korea.

The statement also said that out of the 1,303,126 illegals who had registered under the 6P programme, 1,015,852 had also registered for employment while 287,274 had opted to return to their respective homeland.
