

Chinese Foreign Minister Visits Malaysia Beginning Tomorrow

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 10 (Bernama) -- Chinese Foreign Minister Yang Jiechi will make a three-day official visit to Malaysia beginning tomorrow.

The Foreign Ministry in a statement said the visit is to reciprocate the official visit by Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Anifah Aman to Beijing, China in April last year and part of Yang's tour to Southeast Asian countries, which include Indonesia and Brunei.

During the visit, Yang is scheduled to hold a bilateral meeting with Anifah and to call on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

The visit will provide an opportunity for both ministers to further enhance bilateral relations and strengthen the existing close working relationship between Malaysia and China.

"During their meeting, both foreign ministers are expected to exchange views on various current bilateral, regional and international issues of mutual interests.
