

Federal Government To Provide Filters To Address Water Problems In Kelantan

TUMPAT, Aug 10 (Bernama) -- The federal government will install filters to filter river water as a short-term measure to provide clean water supply to about 5,000 residents in Kampung Derdap and Kampung Tualang here.

Kelantan Federal Development Action Council chairman Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed said the water filters, costing about RM65,000 per unit, would be installed soon in time for the Aidilfitri celebration.

He told this to reporters after a visit to a site at Kampung Kuala Jambu here today where a similar water filter had been installed to filter the river water for use by residents in the village.

Residents in these three villages rely on the river for their source of water supply.

The filters, contributed by Bio Ultra Pure Sdn Bhd, was installed about two months ago.
