

Malaysia Create History By Organising Event To Unite Four Major Indian Ethnic Groups

SHAH ALAM, Aug 11 (Bernama) -- Malaysia has created history by organising the largest first-of-its-kind event, uniting four major Indian ethnic groups, under one roof at the Malawati Stadium here Saturday night.
