

**Opposition Has Never Acknowledged Role Of Women, Says Ng

GEORGE TOWN, Aug 11 (Bernama) -- The opposition has no policies whatsoever for the development of women in this country, said Penang MCA Datuk Seri Dr Ng Yen Yen.

Speaking after opening the Penang MCA annual general meeting here today, she said the opposition has never acknowledged the role of women, unlike the central government which always appreciated their sacrifices towards the nation's progress.

The government has also gone a step further and approved a policy to achieve at least 30 percent of women at the decision making level of the corporate sector, she added.
