

Sabah Government Hails Terms Of Reference Of RCI To Address Illegal Immigrant Issue

KOTA KINABALU, Aug 11 (Bernama) -- The Sabah government and people of Sabah have hailed the attentiveness of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak for laying out a comprehensive terms of reference (TOR) for the Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI) on illegal immigrants in the state.

Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman said he believed that the TOR was all encompassing, fair and transparent.

He said today's TOR disclosure also proved that the Barisan Nasional (BN) government under the leadership of Najib listened to the calls and needs of the people in Sabah and responded to them accordingly.

"The BN leadership is not merely performing lip service. He (Najib) walks the talk and fulfils what he says he will do," he said after the Prime Minister chaired a state BN meeting at Umno building, here Saturday.

Earlier, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak had announced an eight-point terms of reference for the Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI) on Sabah's illegal immigrant issue, which he said had already received the consent of the Yang diPertuan Agong.
