

Two-Day Malaysia-Brunei Annual Leaders Consultation Begins Monday

PUTRAJAYA, Sept 1 (Bernama) -- The 16th Malaysia-Brunei Darussalam Annual Leaders' Consultation is scheduled for Sept 3 and 4 in Putrajaya, the Foreign Ministry said in a statement Saturday.

It said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak would host the official visit of the Sultan of Brunei, Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah, in conjunction with the talks.

The ministry said the two leaders would take the opportunity of the annual meeting to appraise the progress of the ongoing cooperation and explore new potentials for an enhanced partnership that can mutually benefit the peoples of the two countries.

The ministry said the consultation was the most important event in the annual calendar of both countries, serving as a mechanism for discussion on a wide range of bilateral, regional and global issues of common concern.

A joint statement would be issued after the meeting, it said.

Najib and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, would also host a luncheon at the prime minister's official residence, Seri Perdana, in Putrajaya, it added.
