

Raja Of Perlis Tells Members Of Administration To Woo Investors

KANGAR, Sept 5 (Bernama) -- The Raja of Perlis Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Putra Jamalullail has called on members of the Perlis administration not only to discharge their duties with integrity and accountability, but also to entice investors to the state.

He said every investment made would indirectly become a catalyst to the state's development.
