

Najib To Attend OIC Extraordinary Summit In Mecca

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 13 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak will be attending the 4th Session of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) Extraordinary Summit in Mecca for two days from Tuesday.

At the meeting, Najib is scheduled to deliver a statement on Malaysia's stand on issues raised at the summit, the Foreign Ministry said in statement here today.

The Extraordinary OIC Summit is organised by the King of Saudi Arabia, King Abdullah Abdul Aziz Al Saud to discuss various issues engulfing the Islamic world Sunday.

The conference will be preceded with two preparatory meetings, that is the Senior Officials Meeting on Saturday and Sunday and the Ministerial Level meeting on Monday to discuss the latest situation in Islamic countries and the world.

It is also aimed at returning and strengthening world Muslim solidarity and fight elements bringing strife and chaos, according to the ministry.

Najib will be accompanied by his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor as well as Foreign Ministry secretary-general Tan Sri Mohd Radzi Abdul Rahman.
