

**Pakatan Tries To Capitalise On RCI For Political Gain, Says Salleh

KOTA BELUD, Aug 13 (Bernama) -- The opposition parties in the state are not "actually" interested in finding solutions to the perennial illegal immigrant problem through the setting up of a Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI), said Sabah Umno deputy liaison chief Datuk Seri Salleh Said Keruak.

He said the opposition or Pakatan was instead trying to capitalise on the issue of the RCI merely for political gain.

"How can we count the chickens before they are hatched? We should give ample time to the RCI panel members to complete their investigation.

"In fact, the opposition parties are not interested at all in lending a hand to solve the illegal immigrant issue in Sabah.

"That's why they keep on harping on this issue to win the hearts and minds of the voters for the coming general election," he said in a statement, here, Monday.
