

**RCI Boosts People's Confidence In Government: SYC

KOTA KINABALU, Aug 14 (Bernama) -- The Sabah Youth Council (SYC) has lauded the setting up of the Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI) on Illegal Immigrants in Sabah saying it will boost the people's confidence in the Barisan Nasional (BN) government.
