

Selangor BN Reveals Memo Directing Reduction In Production Of Treated Water

SHAH ALAM, Aug 15 (Bernama) - The Selangor Barisan Nasional (BN) today revealed a memo issued by the top management of Kumpulan Perangsang Selangor Berhad (KPS) directing Konsortium Abbas Sdn Bhd (ABBAS) to reduce the production of treated water.

Coordinator Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Mohamed claimed ABBAS was directed to reduce production of treated water from 142 million gallons daily to only 120 million gallons was contained in a memo dated Dec 29, 2011 signed by KPS managing director and chief executive officer, Suhaimi Kamaralzaman.

He said that copies of the memo were sent to National Water Services Commission chief executive officer, Datuk Teo Yen Hua and Syabas chief executive officer, Datuk Ruslan Hassan.

"The directive made after discussion with KPS board of directors caused a water crisis in Kajang and Balakong as ABBAS operates the Sungai Semenyih water treatment plant.

"The reduction in production of treated water shows that the Selangor government stand that it cares for the people is mere rhetoric," he told a press conference at his office here Wednesday.
