

Televideo Conferencing Between Malaysians In Beijing And Najib On 1st Day Of Hari Raya

BEIJING, Aug 18 (Bernama) -- There will be a televideo conferencing between Malaysians living in Beijing and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak at 3pm, on the first day of Hari Raya.

"Around 30 of us will have the opportunity to interact with PM, his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor and members of the Cabinet.

"This is an opportunity for Malaysian officers, students and citizens living abroad, to interact with leaders in Malaysia," Malaysia's Ambassador to China, Datuk Iskandar Sarudin told Bernama, here.

Iskandar said after 2010, this would be the second time Malaysians in Beijing would share their happiness through a televideo conferencing for the coming Hari Raya.

Meanwhile, Iskandar will hold an open house at his official residence, Rumah Malaysia, here on Aug 26 from 7.30pm to 9.30pm.

"We will invite students, Malaysian community, diplomats and local Chinese friends to celebrate Hari Raya together in Malaysian style. Malaysian specialties will be served," he said.
