

MCA Urges DAP To Stand Up Against Pas' Intention To Implement Hudud

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 29 (Bernama) -- MCA vice-president Datuk Seri Chor Chee Heung has urged DAP adviser Lim Kit Siang and his son, Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng to stand up and declare their opposition towards PAS' intention to amend the Constitution to have hudud law.

In a statement Wednesday, Chor said: "DAP must stop beating around the bush and declare their opposition towards this instead of leaving it to their junior leaders to oppose PAS."

He said despite DAP's constant claims that Pakatan would stick to the promises listed in their 'Buku Jingga' and their common policy framework, PAS repeatedly continues to poke holes in DAP's rhetoric and claims.

"This is because PAS does not respect Pakatan's 'Buku Jingga' and its common policy framework. The PAS leadership has also made it clear that implementing hudud law is their main agenda, which is more important than DAP's goal or even the common agreement between the Pakatan parties.

"So, I ask DAP, when will they finally confess to the people, especially the non-Muslims, that they are unable to prevent PAS from implementing hudud if Pakatan forms the federal government?"
