

Kedah MIC Backs Action Against Perpetrators Of Shameful Acts During Illegal Gathering

PADANG SERAI, Sept 7 (Bernama) -- Kedah MIC will not compromise with the attempt to change the Malaysian flag, stomping on pictures of the prime minister and abusing leaders at Dataran Merdeka, recently.

In line with this, its chairman S. Ananthan fully backs Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein to act against the perpetrators of the incidents without fear or favour.

"We agree the suspects who have been detained or have surrendered themselves be charged quickly to get their just dessert," he told reporters, here, today.

"They are traitors for their provocations and insults to our leaders and nation. They surely have masterminds who instigated them to act in such a manner," he added.

He said Hishammuddin's firmness in tackling the issue should be praised and hoped that he would walk the talk as it was not just any issue.

Hishammuddin, in a statement in Batu Pahat yesterday, said although he felt compassion at the apology by the father of private college student Muhammad Ammar A.Rahman, 19, who desecrated pictures of the prime minister, all decisions would be made based on the law.

Ananthan, who is also Lunas state constituency coordinator for BN, hoped the Attorney-General would also be proactive in bringing the culprits to face the law.

"Kedah MIC wants all authorities to play their appropriate role in tackling the issue which is sensitive and concerns the image of the country," he said.
