

Prosecution's Appeal Against Anwar's Acquittal Set For Case Management On Nov 23

PUTRAJAYA, Sept 7 (Bernama) -- The prosecution's appeal against Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's acquittal on a charge of sodomising his former aide Mohd Saiful Bukhari Azlan is fixed for further case management on Nov 23.

Appeals Court deputy registrar N. Kanageswari fixed the date after the case came up for case management before her today.

She fixed another date for case management as the notes of evidence were incomplete and thus the records of appeal were also not complete.

Anwar's counsel Ram Karpal Singh said both the prosecution and defence required time to go through a CD of the recordings of the trial proceedings, before the hearing date is fixed.

On Jan 9 this year, the Kuala Lumpur High Court acquitted and discharged Anwar of sodomising Mohd Saiful, 26, at a Desa Damansara condominium unit in Bukit Damansara, here, between 3.10 pm and 4.30 pm on June 26, 2008.
