

Selangor Will Have Welfare Programmes For All When BN Comes To Power - Mohd Zin

SHAH ALAM, Sept 10 (Bernama) - Selangor people will enjoy welfare programmes for all, regardless of political affiliation, race and religion, when Barisan Nasional (BN) comes to power at the next general election.

Selangor BN coordinator Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Mohamed said welfare programmes of the Selangor Pakatan Rakyat government are flawed as there were complaints of favouritism in the senior citizens and Tabung Warisan Anak Selangor (TAWAS) schemes.

He also explained that the allocation for the salary increase of KAFA (fardhu ain class) Islamic religious teachers was actually obtained from the federal government.
