

**Bersih Rally: Prosecution Withdraws Objection**

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 13 (Bernama) -- The prosecution in the case of Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) adviser Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and two others who have been charged for their participation in the April 28 Bersih 3.0 rally in the city, has withdrawn its objection to the Opposition Leader's application to refer a point of law to the High Court on one of three charges made against them.

Deputy public prosecutor Abdul Wahab Mohamad informed this to Sessions Court Judge Mahmud Abdullah Thursday.

With that, the High Court will hear the application by Anwar and PKR deputy president Mohamed Azmin Ali on a date to be fixed later.

In the application, Anwar stated that the High Court should decide as to whether Section 4(1)(c) and 4(2)(c) of the Peaceful Assembly Act 2012 was in accordance with the Federal Constitution.
