

**Let People Judge Selangor Pakatan Government - Muhyiddin

PUTRAJAYA, Sept 13 (Bernama) - The people can judge the Selangor Pakatan Rakyat government should it decide to hold state election separately from the general election.

Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said Barisan Nasional (BN) at federal and state level is ready for the polls.

"It is up to them as we practice democracy," he said when asked to comment a portal report that the Selangor state election would be held separately.

Muhyiddin said the Pakatan Rakyat government was afraid of losing the general election as the people in Selangor were ready to support Barisan Nasional (BN).

"If Selangor people support BN during parliamentary election, Anwar Ibrahim can tell his followers that Selangor is not lost as there is still the state election."

The portal said the decision was made at Pakatan Rakyat presidential council meeting yesterday citing "unresolved issues" over the electoral roll claiming the existence of thousands of dubious voters.
