

**Kita Announces Seven More Candidates For General Election**

SUNGAI PETANI, Sept 15 (Bernama) -- The Kesejahteraan Insan Tanahair (Kita) party has announced seven more candidates who will contest five state assembly seats and two parliamentary seats in Kedah.

For state assembly seats, the contenders are media personnel A. Appadorai, 59, (Kuala Ketil), businessman Samransak Kram, 27, (Pedu), Azhar Ahmad, 34, (Bakar Bata), Wan Rosli Omar, 40, (Merbau Pulas) and Vincent Tuh, 44, (Bakar Arang).

N. Periasamay, 52, and Sanan Maniratana Eplat, 37, are contesting the Padang Serai and Pendang parliamentary seats, respectively.

Kita president Datuk Zaid Ibrahim said he has confidence in the candidates chosen to contest in Kedah.

"I am confident with the candidates as they are from the community and involved in its activities, this is important. We don't want a candidate among the rich because they (usually) think of themselves first.

"We want someone who understands the people's problems. Our candidates are made up of small businessmen," he told a news conference after attending the Kedah Kita Hari Raya Aidilfitri function here Saturday.
