

**Don't Belittle Election Commission - Abdul Aziz

PUTRAJAYA, Sept 22 (Bernama) - Those who want to help the Election Commission (EC) clean the electoral roll must not belittle and make a fool of the body.

EC chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof said they are welcomed to help but reminded them to use the correct channel.

"Additional voters don't exist only in Selangor but also in other states. Don't say that we plan it. Come and see us if there is any doubt. We are not perfect, we are not superman," he told a press conference here.

Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) secretary-general Saifuddin Nasution Ismail claimed that Lot 4830 Kampung Sungai Pusu, Gombak had 13 registered voters.

Abdul Aziz said EC checks found that the house at the address was used to park motorcycles by residents there. It is actually a coffeeshop with post box for postmen to deliver letters as their houses are located on a hilly area.

"Eighteen people had registered as voters using that address although they have houses inhabited by 32 families.

From 2008 to second quarter 2012, the EC clean up of electoral roll involved 480,229 voters with the highest number recorded in Perak, Johor, Selangor, Kedah and Kelantan.
