

Ibrahim Ali Hits Out At Opposition Move To Table Their Budget

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 25 (Bernama) -- Pasir Mas MP Datuk Ibrahim Ali today hit out at the opposition pact for ignoring the government and insisting on tabling their budget for next year in the Dewan Rakyat tomorrow.

"They should respect the ruling government which, with the mandate of the people and under the patronage of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, will table Budget 2013 in the Dewan Rakyat on Friday.

"There is nothing to stop the opposition from tabling their budget, but they should show some respect and not ignore the government," he told reporters at the lobby of Parliament House.

Ibrahim said the opposition seemed to be afraid and worried about the budget to be tabled on Friday, so much so that they wanted to beat the government to it.

"Is the opposition worried that the government's budget will be people-friendly and undermine them?" he asked.

Ibrahim said the opposition move was merely for political mileage and the people should guard against being fooled by their agenda.
