

Parliament: KL Boasts Four Permanent Forest Reserves

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 25 (Bernama) -- Only four areas have been gazetted as permanent forest reserves in the Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur until Aug 31.

They are the Sungai Besi Forest Reserve, the Bukit Sungei Putih Forest Reserve (both in the Bandar Tun Razak parliamentary constituency), the Bukit Nanas (Bukit Bintang) Forest Reserve, and the Bukit Lagong (Kepong) Forest Reserve, said Natural Resources and Environment Minister Datuk Seri Douglas Uggah Embas.

The total area of permanent forest reserves gazetted in the Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur is 68.27 ha, he said in a written reply to a question from Lim Lip Eng (DAP-Segambut) at the Dewan Rakyat Tuesday.

He said currently no new areas would be gazetted as permanent forest reserve.
