

PKR challenges Muhyiddin to name designated Selangor MB

PETALING JAYA, Sept 21 — An opposition leader today challenged Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin to name the designated menteri besar if Barisan Nasional (BN) were to wrest Selangor back in the upcoming general election.

Pakatan Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) women's chief Zuraida Kamaruddin (picture) made this statement today in response to the deputy prime minister's statement last Sunday that problem-beset Selangor state government provided the right "recipe" for BN to score success in the state.

The Ampang MP today questioned Muhyiddin's "recipe" and Putrajaya's readiness by challenging the deputy prime minister to name the designated MB if BN were to take over Selangor in the general election.

"Until today there is no recipe. Until today he is unable to identify the shortlist (of candidates)," she said today.

"Who is going to take over?" she asked.

"His (Muhyiddin's) recipe is not complete if he can't even tell who is MB therefore his recipe is half-baked and half-cooked."

Zuraida also questioned Muhyiddin's interest in the state, pointing out that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak was Selangor BN chairman.

"Why is he taking over Selangor from Najib?" she asked.

On Sunday, Muhyiddin said the "environment" is right for BN to wrest Selangor back but success will depend on whether Umno members can refrain from acts of sabotage and work together.

The Umno deputy president also said in the four years of Pakatan Rakyat rule, many issues and problems had cropped up which the state had failed to resolve.

He said wherever he went in Selangor, the public and the business community would complain about the state government.
