

**PAS, DAP Cooperation Against Islamic Requirements - Shahnun

GEORGE TOWN, Oct 8 (Bernama) -- PAS' political struggle no longer conformed with Islamic requirements when the party cooperated with DAP, National Laureate Prof Emeritus Datuk Dr Shahnun Ahmad said today.

He said what PAS did now was merely to conform to the political demands of DAP, which he claimed was against Islamic teachings.

Shahnun, who is PAS life member, said he found the situation saddening because the approach taken by the party in befriending DAP was not consistent with the approach taken by the Prophet, in working together with non-Muslims.

"DAP should observe Islamic regulations if it wants to cooperate with PAS," he told Bernama when contacted here.

The former Sik member of parliament said PAS had deviated from its original struggle when it chose to give in to DAP demands.

Shahnun was formerly director of Universiti Sains Malaysia's Islamic Centre.
