

Najib Hopes Thai FM's Visit Will Strengthen Ties

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 10 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said on Wednesday he hoped that the recent visit of Thailand Foreign Minister Dr Surapong Tovichakchaikul to Malaysia would strengthen bilateral relations.

Dr Surapong had arrived in Kuala Lumpur on Sunday on his maiden official visit to Malaysia over two days.

"Hosted Thai Foreign Minister Dr Surapong in my office. Hope to strengthen bilateral relationship we have between our two countries," Najib said in his latest tweet.

The two countries are stepping up efforts to consolidate mutually beneficial and wide-ranging cooperation in many areas, including trade and investment, security, education and vocational training, youth and sports, tourism, connectivity, as well as socio-economic development in the border areas.

Bilateral trade continues to register an upward trend, with last year's trade value at US\$22.95 billion (about RM70.5 billion).
