

Penang's Development Fruit Of BN Government's Efforts, Says Cheng Liang

GEORGE TOWN, Oct 10 (Bernama) -- Penang Barisan Nasional (BN) Information Bureau chief Tan Cheng Liang said on Wednesday that all development for the welfare of Penangites thus far was due to the BN's efforts.

Every facility enjoyed by the people in the state had been funded by the BN government, including the RM4.5-billion Second Penang Bridge to resolve the prevailing traffic congestion, he added.

He was speaking to reporters here after a briefing by Jambatan Kedua Sdn Bhd (JKSB) on the progress of the bridge construction, organised by the bureau to obtain an update and refute opposition claims that the BN government was neglecting Penang.

Tan also criticised the opposition for claiming that the federal government ignored Penang and for constantly finding fault with the BN government whenever a technical fault occurred.

The second bridge project is scheduled for completion in September next year, ahead of the initial date of November 2013, he said.
