

BN MPs Ready To Expose Weaknesses Of Opposition's Budget To The People

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 11 (Bernama) -- Barisan Nasional (BN) MPs Thursday said they were ready to go to the ground to explain what has been described as fraud in the opposition's alternative budget.

In a special media conference held at Parliament's lobby, the elected representatives said they felt compelled to explain that the promises of the opposition's budget did not protect the people's interests.

"Many of the calculations are simple yet they made mistakes and their promises are not supported by financial sources," said Kota Belud MP Datuk Abdul Rahman Dahlan.

Second Finance Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Husni Hanadzlah was reported as asking the government not to wait too long in explaining to the people the advantages of the 2013 Budget tabled by the government recently in comparison to the opposition's budget.

Hulu Selangor MP P.Kamalanathan said the opposition coalition's budget was irresponsible and it did not address the issue of national debt.
