

**Malaysia Elected To Postal Operations Council At Universal Postal Union Congress
In Qatar

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 11 (Bernama) -- Malaysia was elected to the Postal Operations Council (POC) at the 25th Universal Postal Union (UPU) Congress in Doha, Qatar, yesterday.

The POC, which is made up of 40 member countries, was heavily contested by the UPU member countries.

Deputy Minister of Information, Communications and Culture, Datuk Maglin Dennis D'Cruz who is leading the Malaysian delegation in Doha said: "The win reflects the UPU member countries' trust and confidence in Malaysia's contributions and leadership in various UPU committees and project groups."

The Malaysian delegation comprised senior officials from the ministry, Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission and Pos Malaysia Berhad, said Pos Malaysia Berhad in a statement faxed to Bernama, here, today.

The Council deals with technical operational issues affecting the international postal sector and promotes the introduction of new postal products and makes recommendations to member countries concerning standards for technological, operational and other processes.
