KUDAT, Oct 14 (Bernama) -- The presence of tens of thousands people at the Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's meet the people session here signifies the people's overwhelming support for the Barisan Nasional (BN), said Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman.
