

Government's Training Stint To Help Graduates Get Jobs In Service Industry

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 14 (Bernama) -- Unemployed graduates have a unique opportunity to attend a six-week training programme sponsored by the government and get a chance to get a job.

The Graduate Career Accelerated Programme (GCAP) offers a skills' upgrading training programme designed to transform graduates into highly employable executives for the service industry.

The training is intense experiential and interactive which is intended to fast develop the hallmarks of an attractive hire and prepare the unemployed graduates to take on the challenges of today's highly competitive job market.
