

Government Pleased With Private And Public Sectors' Commitment To Developing Cyberjaya

CYBERJAYA, Oct 16 (Bernama) -- The government is pleased with the private and public sectors' level of commitment in rolling out various projects in Cyberjaya, where the development is seen as on track with "nothing less than growth expected".

Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Datuk Seri Dr Maximus Ongkili said Cyberjaya's accelerated growth in the last few years was no doubt backboned by the robust, fibre-optic high-speed capacity network that provided the confidence required for the international and local companies to establish operations here.

"I have been made to understand that Setia Haruman Sdn Bhd (Cyberjaya's master developer) has laid more than 35 kilometres of fibre-optic cable that interconnects all buildings in redundancy design network.

"This is to cater to the information and communication technology (ICT) industry requirement for high-speed capacity throughout the city and it is being operated on an open access network," he said when opening the Cyberjaya Infra Conference and Exhibition 2012, here, Tuesday.

Also present were Multimedia Development Corporation (MDeC) chief executive officer Datuk Mohd Badlisham Ghazali, Setia Haruman director Datuk P. Kasi and Cyberview Sdn Bhd managing director Ir Hafidz Hashim.
