

Selangor Willing To Discuss Water Issue With Federal Government

SHAH ALAM, Sept 26 (Bernama) -- The Selangor government is willing to hold discussions with the federal government through Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin on the water issue in the state.

Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim said this would be stated in his reply letter to Muhyiddin to be sent to the latter within two days.

"The state executive council has agreed to invite Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin for discussions on the water issue," he told reporters, here, Wednesday.

Khalid said the state government believed that the discussions would have a positive outcome for the state's water industry and the people in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya.

"I feel the deputy prime minister needs to know the issues that have to be resolved before the state government can make an offer to the concessionaires, which now have been given extension to operate from month to month by the National Water Services Commission (SPAN)," he said.
