

**Opposition's Alternative Budget Less Than Credible - BN Lawmakers

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 27 (Bernama) -- The Barisan National lawmakers chided the alternative budget announced by the opposition pact today, describing it as less than credible and was only aimed at fishing for votes in view of the next general election.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Mohd Nazri Abdul Aziz said the budget was just another sweet lie to trick the people.

"It is just...to trick people to vote for them by giving a lot of promises, but nothing have been done," he told reporters at the Parliament lobby here Wednesday.

Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Seri Chor Chee Heung believed that the opposition's budget was unprofessional and would destroy the country's economy if implemented.

Hulu Selangor Member of Parliament P.Kamalanathan, on the other hand, described the budget as impossible to be implemented.

Setiu Member of Parliament Datuk Mohd Jidin Shafee said the opposition's plan to scrap the 1Malaysia Development Berhad would definitely affect the government's efforts to help the Bumiputera.
