

Najib Returns After Attending ASEM Summit In Laos

SHAH ALAM, Nov 6 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak returned today after attending the 9th Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM) summit in Vientiane, Laos.

The special aircraft carrying Najib and his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, landed at the Royal Malaysia Air Force (RMAF) base in Subang near here at 4.20 pm.

Najib and Rosmah were welcomed at the base by Deputy Information, Communications and Culture Minister Datuk Maglin Dennis D'Cruz and People's Progressive Party (PPP) president Datuk M. Kayveas.

The prime minister had joined 48 other leaders from Asia and Europe at the two-day summit which ended Tuesday.

At the summit, which had the theme "Friends for Peace, Partners for Prosperity", the ASEM leaders discussed regional and international issues of common interest, including food and energy security, sustainable development, financial crisis and the economy.
