

**Personal Sufferings Of Palestinians To Be Heard At Upcoming War Crime Conference**

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 6 (Bernama) -- Malaysians will have the opportunity to hear a group of Palestinians' personal accounts of their sufferings in Gaza at the four-day conference on war crimes beginning this Nov 19 at the Putra World Trade Centre, here.

The conference is organised by the Kuala Lumpur Foundation to Criminalise War (KLFCW) and the Perdana Global Peace Foundation (PGPF).

For the first time, the organisers will be bringing 10 Palestinians from the Gaza Strip to relate their experience living in the blockaded enclave at the session called Kuala Lumpur War Crimes Commission Hearing on Palestine.

PGPF senior associate member, Fauziah Abu Hassan @ Ajie Hassan said all information obtained during the second and third day of the conference would be compiled as proof to be forwarded to the prosecution team for action.

Former prime minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who is also PGPF and KLFCW chairman, is expected to deliver the keynote address at the forum, "9/11 Revisited - Seeking the Truth" to be held on the first day of the conference.

A war crime exhibition and International Conference on War-affected Children will also be part of the four-day programme, with paper presenters who include Dr Mahathir's wife Tun Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, Prof Francis A.Boyle from the University of Illinois and Malaysian AIDS Council president Datuk Dr Raj Abdul Karim.

Fauziah said a dinner function would be held on the last day where 17 students from 17 countries including Malaysia would sign the proclamation and inscription of the Children's Charter to Criminalise War.
